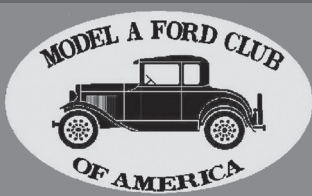
The Board voted to hire Pam Lundy (Pam also publishes our newsletter) to update the Tulsa Club website. Pam has considerable experience in developing websites and we are

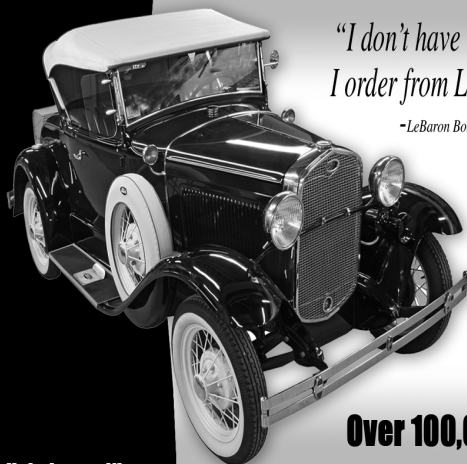
### Frozen Food Sale by Roy Cail

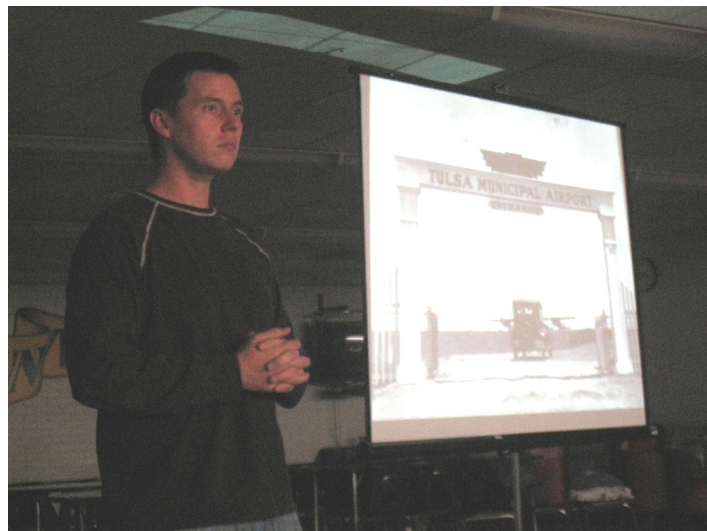

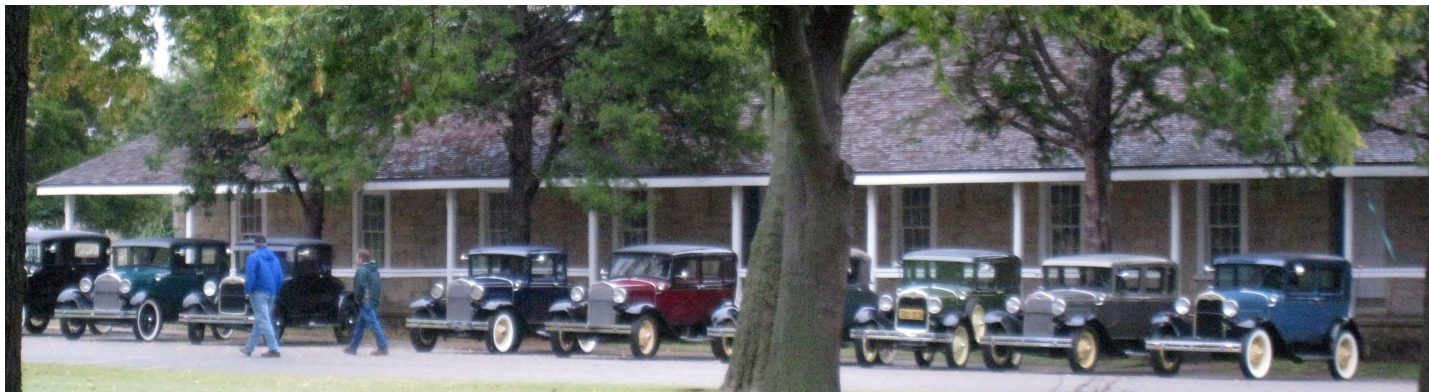
